ADMISSIONS ANNOUNCEMENT FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2012/2013

Hubert Kairuki Memorial University (HKMU), is an accredited and chartered University, recognized by the Government of the United Republic of Tanzania, through the Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU).

Applications for admission are invited from qualified candidates wishing to pursue various programmes at HKMU for the academic year 2012/2013. Applicants with 'A' level qualifications (Direct Entrants) should apply for admission directly to the Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU). More information on how to apply is available at TCU office and website www.tcu.go.tz.

APPLICANTS WITH EQUIVALENT QUALIFICATIONS OBTAINED PRIOR TO 2012 SHOULD APPLY DIRECTLY TO HKMU.

Applications are hereby invited for the following academic programmes:

A) UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES OFFERED BY HKMU

1. DOCTOR OF MEDICINE (MD) PROGRAMME:

Entry requirements:

- a) Applicants must have completed Form VI (Advanced Level of Secondary Education) or its equivalent, with at least two Principal Level Passes (with not less than a total of 4.5 points), one of which must be at a level of D or above in any of the following subjects: Chemistry, Biology or Physics; Or
- b) Equivalent Applicants who are holders of Medical Assistant/Clinical Officers Diploma /Certificates, Diploma in Nursing or Dental Assistant, who have Principal Passes in Chemistry, Biology or Physics at the Advanced Level Certificate of Secondary Education (National Form VI or its equivalent), with not less than 3.0 points and a minimum working experience of two years ; Or
- c) Applicants who have successfully completed a one-semester HKMU Pre-university entry programme, or any other transferable pre-university programme / matriculation examination.

Duration of the programme: 5 Years (plus one year internship).

2. BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING (BSCN) PRE-SERVICE PROGRAMME:

Entry requirements:

a) Applicants must have completed Form VI (Advanced Level of Secondary Education) or its equivalent, with at least two Principal Level Passes (with not less than a total of 4.5 points), one of which must be at a level of D or above in any of the following subjects: Chemistry, Biology or Physics; Or

b) Equivalent Applicants who are holders of Medical Assistant/Clinical Officers Diploma /Certificates, Diploma in Nursing or Dental Assistant, who have Principal Passes in Chemistry, Biology or Physics at the Advanced Level Certificate of Secondary Education (National Form VI or its equivalent), with not less than 3.0 points and a minimum working experience of two years ; Or

c) Applicants who have successfully completed a one-semester HKMU Pre-university entry programme, or any other transferable pre-university programme / matriculation examination.

Duration of the programme: 4 Years (plus one year internship).

3. BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING (BSCN) IN-SERVICE PROGRAMME:

Entry requirements:

1. Applicants must have completed form IV (Ordinary Level Certificate of Secondary Education or its equivalent), with at least three credit passes in, Chemistry, Biology, Physics or Mathematics, with a Diploma in Nursing, registered by the Nurses' Councils of their respective countries, with at least a working experience of two years in a recognized hospital; Or

2. Applicants who have successfully completed a one-semester HKMU Pre-university entry programme, or any other transferable pre-university programme / matriculation examination.

Duration of the programme: 3 years.

B) POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES OFFERED BY HKMU:

4. HKMU OFFERS POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN:

- i) OBSTETRICS AND GYNAECOLOGY**
- ii) PAEDIATRICS AND CHILD HEALTH**

Entry requirements: This programme is open to candidates who hold an MD degree or its equivalent, and who have completed internship in their respective countries. Applicants must have a credit in the subject field for which they are applying.

Duration of the programme: 12 months.

5. MASTER OF MEDICINE (MMED) PROGRAMME:

HKMU offers Master of Medicine Degree programme in the following specialities:

- i) SURGERY**
- ii) OBSTETRICS AND GYNAECOLOGY**
- iii) PAEDIATRICS AND CHILD HEALTH**

Entry requirements: Holder of good MD or MBChB degree or equivalent, normally with at least B grade in the subject intended specialization. Working experience of one year as a Medical Officer, after one-year internship.

Duration of the programme: 4 years.

D) CERTIFICATE PROGRAMMES OFFERED BY HKMU

8. CERTIFICATE IN WHOLISTIC THERAPEUTIC COUNSELING:

Wholistic Therapeutic Counseling programme is conducted by the department of Behavioural Sciences and Ethics. The programme is tailor made for: Corporate / parastatals Personnel Officers, Matrons/Patrons from secondary schools, Wardens, School Principals, Administrators, Students' Advisers and Health Professionals/Workers.

Entry Requirements: Ordinary Certificate of Secondary School Education or its equivalent.

Duration of the programme: 3 months.

Starting dates: Early February 2012, and Early August 2012.

Days and Time: Monday to Friday, from: 03:00pm to 05:00pm

Deadline for receiving applications for the Wholistic Therapeutic Counseling course is January 25th, and July 25th, 2012.

9. PRE-UNIVERSITY ENTRY PROGRAMME:

The Pre-University Entry Programme offered at HKMU, is designed to provide a sound theoretical and practical foundation in basic sciences subjects to students, who fall short of the entry qualifications to the degree programmes. The certificate awarded which is recognised by the Tanzania Commission for Universities may help the student to acquire admission into other Universities/Colleges of her/his choice.

Entry Requirements:

- i. Applicants who have gone through the 8-4-4 education system and passed Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics at **B** grade and above; Or
- ii. Direct applicants who have three credits at O-level or its equivalent in relevant subjects, and at least A-level passes at **E** grade or two principals of not less than 3.0 points. Female applicants with two principal passes at **E** grade may be considered provided they do not have **F** grades in the other two subjects; Or
- iii. Equivalent qualification: applicants who hold a Diploma in any allied health science. Such applicants must have three credits at O-level or its equivalent in relevant subjects, and at least two principal passes at **E** grade in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, or Mathematics at the Advanced Level Certificate of Secondary Education.

Duration of the programme - 24 weeks (October to March) each year. Deadline for

receiving applications for the Pre-University Entry programme is 31st August each year.

MODE OF APPLICATION: Eligible applicants for the courses mentioned above, should send application letters with a non-refundable fee of Tshs. 30,000/= or USD 30.00, by postal money order or cash payment to the University Bursar. ADMISSIONS ANNOUNCEMENT FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2012/2013

1. ORDINARY DIPLOMA PROGRAMME IN NURSING (NTA level 4) PRE-SERVICE PROGRAMME:

The Ordinary Diploma Programme in Nursing (NTA Level 4) Pre-Service, is a programme that is meant to take students who have never attended nursing training before.

Entry requirements: Applicants who have a minimum of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) or its equivalent, with three passes in science subjects: Biology, Chemistry, Physics /Mathematics at least grade D or above. A pass in English is an added advantage.

Duration of the programme: 3 years

2. DIPLOMA PROGRAMME IN NURSING (NTA level 6) IN-SERVICE PROGRAMME:

The Ordinary Diploma Programme in Nursing (NTA Level 6) In-Service, aims at educating nurses who have already undergone basic training in Nursing.

Entry requirements:

1. Applicants who have a minimum of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) or its equivalent, with passes in science subjects: Biology, Chemistry, Physics /Mathematics at grade D or above. A pass in Chemistry is an added advantage.

2. Candidates must hold a certificate in Nursing and Midwifery (Nurse B), licensed to practice as an enrolled Nurse and Midwife, with a working experience of at least two years in a reputable hospital.

Duration of the programme: 1 year

MODE OF APPLICATION: Eligible applicants for the courses mentioned above, should send application letters with a non-refundable fee of Tshs.30,000/= or USD 30.00, by postal money order or cash payment to the University Bursar.
