

5. Master of Medicine (M.MED) in:

- i. Internal Medicine
- ii. Surgery
- iii. Obstetrics and Gynaecology
- iv. Paediatrics and Child Health

Entry requirements: Holder of good MD or MBChB degree or equivalent, normally with at least a B grade in the subject of intended specialization. Working experience of one year as a Medical Officer, after one-year internship.

Duration of the programme: 4 years.

6. Diploma in Nursing/Midwifery or Psychiatry (In-Service)

Entry requirement:

- i. Applicants who have completed Form IV (Ordinary Level Certificate of Secondary Education or its equivalent) with at least passes in Biology and English and any other Science subject.
- ii. A pass in an entry examination conducted by the Ministry of Health or School of Nursing at the Regional Headquarters or School.
- iii. A minimum of three years working experience as an enrolled Nurse/Midwife.

Duration of the programme: 2 years.

7. Certificate in Wholistic Therapeutic Counseling

In response to the increasing number of individuals with biosociopsychological problems, resulting from HIV/AIDS entanglement, drug abuse, parenthood adolescent crisis, change problems in work place etc, the department of Behavioral Sciences and Ethics introduced a Certificate Course in Wholistic Therapeutic Counseling. The programme is tailor-made for: Corporate/Parastatals Personnel Officers, Matrons/Patrons from secondary schools, Wardens, School Principals, Administrators, Students' Advisers and Health Professionals/Workers.

Entry Requirements: Before being admitted into the course, candidates must have obtained Ordinary Level Certificate of Secondary Education or its equivalent (completed Form IV). Social workers are encouraged.

Duration of the Programme: 3 months.

Starting Dates: October, January and May of each year.

Days: Monday to Friday, from: 03:00pm to 05:00pm.

8. Pre-University Entry Programme

The Pre-University Entry Programme offered at HKMU, is designed to provide a sound theoretical and practical foundation in basic sciences subjects, to students who fall short of the entry qualifications into the Doctor of Medicine (MD), or Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BScN) degree programmes at HKMU. The certificate awarded (which is recognized by the Tanzania Commission for Universities) may help the student to acquire admission into other Universities/Colleges of her/his choice.

Entry Requirements:

- i. Direct applicants who have at least three A-level Passes at E grade. Female applicants with two principal pass may be considered provided they do not have F grades in the other subjects; Or
- ii. Equivalent applicants who hold a Diploma in any allied health science. Such applicants, must have at least three Credits at O-level or its equivalent in relevant subjects, and at least two Principal Passes in Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Mathematics, at Advanced Level Certificate of Secondary Education; Or
- iii. Applicants who have gone through the 8-4-4 education system, and passed Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics at B grade or above; or those who fall short of one science subject.

Subjects to be taught: Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Basic Mathematics and English.

Course Duration: One semester of 24 weeks between January and July every year.

9. Other Programmes

HKMU in collaboration with the MMH is involved in several Research, Consultancy and Public/Community Service programmes on:

- Public Health Education, through publicly and privately owned radio and Television networks.
- Continuing Medical Education and computer literacy courses for all staff.
- Research projects and programmes under the Directorate of Postgraduate Studies and Research.
- Free of charge outreach programmes for needy mothers, children, and schools in communities surrounding the hospital.

Background Information

The Hubert Kairuki Memorial University (HKMU), is a fully accredited University, recognized by the Government of United Republic of Tanzania, through the Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU).

HKMU is part of a Non-Governmental Organization, known as the Mission Mikocheni Health and Education Network (MMHEN), incorporating the Mission Mikocheni Hospital (MMH). The University is named after its founder, The Late Prof. Hubert C.M. Kairuki, who was also the institution's first Vice-Chancellor.

Vision Statement

The Vision of HKMU is to become a model private university in Tanzania, and in Africa: a University that provides highest quality education, conducts cutting edge research, and provides exemplary service to society.

Location

HKMU is located at Plot No. 322 Regent Estate in Mikocheni area, Kinondoni district, some 7km from Dar es Salaam City centre.

Facilities

HKMU has a wide range of teaching, learning, and research facilities; including several well-equipped teaching laboratories, research laboratories, and a library. The

university library has a large number of major reference works, textbooks and journals, and maintains a computerized catalogue. There is also an Internet facility with fulltime Internet access available for staff and students. In addition there is a book bank through which students can access books through a loan system or direct purchase.

Accommodation

The University has a hostel for male and female students. The hostel is located opposite the existing University building in Mikocheni. Besides providing students' accommodation, the hostel also offers various municipal services: the business centre, which incorporates an internet café, a stationery and books store, cafeteria to sit 120 people, associated kitchen and stores, and a multifunction terrace to sit 280 people. Supermarkets and banks are located within walking distance from the campus.

The University Teaching Hospital

The Mission Mikocheni Hospital (MMH) serves as the teaching hospital for HKMU. MMH has direct access to state-of-the-art diagnostic and treatment facilities, including, among others: a modern CT Scanner, Ultrasound and X-Ray Machines (Fluoroscopy), Operating Theatres, and in and out patient facilities. Practical training is also carried out at Amana Hospital, Mwananyamala Hospital, Magomeni RCH, Muhimbili National Hospital, Muhimbili Orthopaedic Institute (MOI), Ocean Road Cancer Institute (Dar es Salaam), Mirembe Hospital (Dodoma), and through field studies, to give students further exposure to a wide range of patients and conditions.

Tuition Fee

Applicants for courses offered by HKMU are advised to apply for scholarship from either the Government of the United Republic of Tanzania, for the Medical Doctor and Postgraduate Programmes, or from the Higher Education Students' Loans Board, or other funding agencies. Academic Programmes:

1. Doctor of Medicine (M.D)

Entry requirements:

- i. Applicants must have at least two Principal Level Passes (with not less than a total of 4.5 points), one of which must be at a level of D or better in any of the following subjects: Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Mathematics, attained in the Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education (National Form VI) or its equivalent; Or
- ii. Applicants who are holders of Medical Assistant/Clinical Officers Diploma/Certificates, Diploma in Nursing or Dental Assistant, who have Principal Passes in Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Mathematics at the Advanced Level Certificate of Secondary Education (National Form VI or its equivalent), with not less than 3.0 points and a minimum working experience of two years; Or
- iii. Applicants who have successfully completed a one-semester HKMU Pre-university entry programme, or any other transferable pre-university programme/matriculation examination.

Duration of the programme: 5 Years (plus one year internship).

2. Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BScN) In-Service Programme

Entry requirements:

- i. Applicants must have completed Form IV (Ordinary Level Certificate of Secondary Education or its equivalent) with at least 3 credit passes in Physics, Chemistry, Biology or English, with a Diploma in Nursing, registered by the Nurses's Councils of their respective countries, with at least a working experience of two years in a recognized hospital; Or
- ii. Applicants who have successfully completed a one-semester HKMU Pre-university entry programme, or any other transferable pre-university programme/matriculation examination.

Duration of the programme: 3 years.

3. Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BScN) Pre-Service Programme

Entry requirements:

- i. Applicants who have completed Form VI (Advance Level Certificate of Secondary Education or its equivalent) with two Principle Level Passes in Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Mathematics.

Duration of the programme: 4 Years (plus one year of Internship).

4. Post Graduate Programmes.

Postgraduate Diploma in:

- i. Obstetrics and Gynaecology
- ii. Paediatrics and Child Health

Entry requirements: This programme is open to candidates who hold an MD degree or its equivalent, and who have completed internship in their respective countries. Applicants must have a credit in the subject field for which they are applying.

Duration of the programme: 12 months.
